
What is an ANGLE?

Math:

"The space between two intersecting lines or surfaces at or close to the point where they meet."

- Other definitions:
 - A fishhook.
 - ► A POINT OF VIEW

Writing: The space between what interests you and what interests your reader or close to the point where they meet.

The Kinds of HOOK

A Metaphor

Compare your subject to another thing

"Going to a Blogging Workshop is like creating your own space in the vast world wide web.

"The Chocolate Concord Cake is a taste of heaven."

A Question

- Compel your reader to think of an answer
- May be a rhetorical question or not

Examples:

"What is a perfect day?"

"Do you know the basic steps to a beautiful face?"

A Definition

"Beouf Bourguignon is a classic French dish of beef stewed in red wine."

"A solar bottle bulb is a recycled soda or water bottle filled with filtered water and bleach fitted into a house roof designed to refract the sunlight to provide daytime light inside a building."

A Quote

"Leadership and learning are indispensable to each other," said the late John F. Kennedy, former USA President.

"Find something you're passionate about and keep tremendously interested in it."

- Julia Child, Celebrity Chef

An Anecdote

"When I was young, we'd always go out for lunch of Sundays. Some of those Sundays, we would go to a department store after lunch. Mommy and Daddy would tell us we can pick one cheap toy. And most of the time, I'd end up choosing a "luto luto," a cheap set of cooking toys."

A Bold or Strong Statement

"Bloggers are nothing but frustrated writers."

"The Blackberry Z10 is the only gadget you will ever need."

A Statistic, Trivia, or Fact

► Make sure it's ACCURATE.

"Over 100,000 Filipino children have been diagnosed with Down Syndrome."

"As of May 2, 2013, Facebook has 1.11 billion users."
